6TH GRADE COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT

6 hours minimum required by May _

Volunteer service requires that you work for a person, organization, or purpose in which you will not be paid. Volunteer service is an activity designed to teach you about a career, help your community, but most importantly help you to become an active member of that community. Remember that it should not already be a responsibility of yours - try something new!

GUIDELINES

- You must complete a MINIMUM of TWO HOURS PER TRIMESTER for a TOTAL OF SIX HOURS for the entire year (Do not procrastinate with this project - 6 hours is not a lot of time in 6 months, but it is a lot to try and accomplish in a day)

- Those who complete 50+ hours will receive a special recognition at the end of the year at promotion
- Majority of hours MUST be done with a non-profit organization
- Other ideas for hours may be performed at churches, senior centers, or PTA/LEAP functions

- Helping teachers in classrooms, babysitting, filing or working at an office are not suitable places to receive community service hours

RECEIVING CREDIT FOR YOUR HOURS

- Make sure the half sheet ("Volunteer Verification") is completed for your total hours completed for EACH different organization/community service opportunity

- Keep track of your total hours in the full sheet service log

DISPLAY PROJECT

- You will create a small poster board (which will be provided to you by your teacher) to display information on one of your community service organizations.

- You will need at least ONE picture of yourself completing hours with that organization.
- Gather information on the organization to present on your display board that will inform on
 - 1) the organization's goal or main focus
 - 2) your job description
 - 3) what you learned from your experience
 - 4) how community service in general is a positive experience
